

# The Old Courthouse ~ *directions*



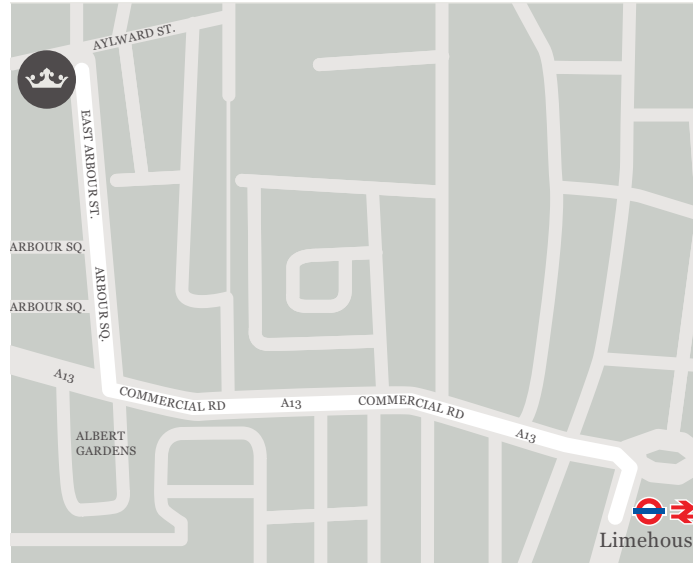
## *Main Entrance*

Aylward Street

The main entrance to The Old Courthouse is situated on Aylward Street, with the building also running along East Arbour Street. It is within walking distance of Stepney Green tube station and Limehouse DLR and National Rail station.

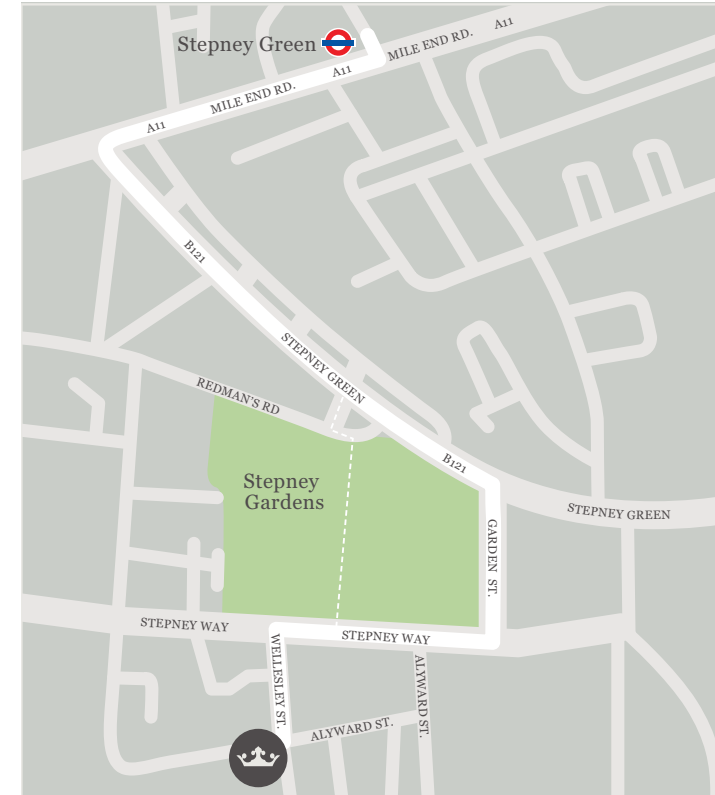

## *From Limehouse Station*

DLR  
National Rail  
Distance: 0.8km / 0.5 miles

Exit the station turning right in order to walk up to join Commercial Road. Turn left to walk west along Commercial Road for 500 metres until you see East Arbour Street on your right, opposite Albert Gardens square on your left. Walk north up East Arbour Street, passing Arbour Square gardens on your left. The Old Courthouse will be on your left, marked by the arched entrance to its car park. To gain entrance via the main hallway, walk up to the junction with Aylward Street and turn left. You will see the main entrance beneath the arch and stonework Royal Coat of Arms.



## *From Stepney Green Station*

District Line  
Hammersmith and City Line  
Distance: 1.1km / 0.7 miles

Exit the station turning right in order to walk west along Mile End Road. After 300 metres, turn left down Stepney Green. You will arrive at the edge of Stepney Gardens park next to the junction with Redman's Road, on your right. You can either take the footpath directly across the park to reach Stepney Way, or skirt the park by walking down Garden Street. From Stepney Way, head down Wellesley Street. After 50 metres or so, you will be at the junction with Aylward Street. The Old Courthouse will be directly on the corner opposite to you, and the main entrance can be found on Aylward Street, beneath the arch and stonework Royal Coat of Arms.
